## FAQ: Why are these libraries needed?








Market prices of adapted toys and devices can be 3-5x that of normal toys, placing additional financial burden on families/guardians already navigating inordinate care-related costs. Given children's quickly changing interests and these high costs, people with disabilities tend not to have adequate access to them for play, inclusion and independence. Items are available on loan so they can be tested before a costly purchase.






# Adapted Toys (Switch Required)

UCP 00546	<b>Dora the Explorer</b> 	This switch activated Dora pumps her arms and sways side to side to the beat. Includes 4 modes of play.
UCP 04060	<b>Backyardigan Tyrone the Moose</b> 	Tyrone the Moose from the Backyardigans is a fun switch adapted friend that talks and sings.
UCP 00549	<b>Backyardigan Cowgirl Tasha</b> 	Cowgirl Tasha from the Backyardigans is a fun switch adapted friend that talks and sings.
UCP 00604	<b>Lovely Monkey</b> 	The plush lovely monkey is a fun switch-adapted friend that walks, talks and makes animal sounds when a capability switch is pressed.
UCP 00607	<b>Crawling Crab Switch Toy</b> 	This cute little crab is made of soft fabric and activates any device. Plays music and vibrates.
UCP 00605	<b>Little Einstein's Classical Friend Leo</b> 	Talks and sings to 2 classical songs when the user squeeze's Leo's belly or uses a capability switch.
UCP 00200	<b>Switch Adapted Clip-On Fan</b> 	Press to feel the breeze and release switch to stop it. Great for teaching cause-effect, providing sensory input, and cooling off on a hot day.

UCP 00627	<b>Butterfly Spinner</b> 	Introduces cause and effect. Press a capability switch and create a swirling blend of colors and music. Watch as the butterflies and ladybugs spin around. Encourages visual attention and enhances auditory skills.
UCP 00631	<b>Fishy Facination Switch</b> 	Spin the fish carousel and be rewarded with spectacular multi-colored blinking lights, music and vibration.
UCP 01428	<b>Dora Bubble Blower</b> 	Use any capability switch to activate Dora and have tons of fun with all the bubbles.  <i>Note: can be used with or without a switch</i>
UCP 02621	<b>Sky High Fubbles Bubble Machine</b> 	Get ready to dance and play under a cloud of bubbles! The Sky-High Bubble Machine uses seven bubble wands to create tons of bubbles that fly up in the air and gently float down. Just fill the reservoir on the top of the machine and push the button of a capability switch and watch the fun begin.
UCP 00630	<b>Castle Music Box</b> 	User activates a capability switch and the King and Queen will dance around the castle while a lullaby plays.
UCP 01298	<b>Rocket Ride Carousel</b> 	Nostalgic tin toy merry-go-round with 3 "rockets", The bright colors of the rockets is a feast for the eyes. Works with a capability switch.
UCP 00626 (2 available)	<b>Vibrating Light with Music</b> 	Press the orange textured plate and enjoy visual auditory and tactile sensations. Available with or without music, both versions can be used as a switch to activate adapted devices.  <i>Note: Can be used with and without a switch.</i>









UCP 00562	<b>Multi-Sensory SpongeBob SquarePants</b> 	<p>This device has a tactile switch plate and vibrates while lights and music play whenever it is pressed. Can be used on its own to teach cause and effect, or to trigger other devices that need a capability switch.</p>
UCP 01244	<b>Musical Carousel</b> 	<p>The user can use this musical instrument in four different ways: activate the attached yellow switch and the colorful bells twirl around sounding the musical scale while the multi-colored LEDs blink; or use your own capability switch to activate the toy.</p> <p><i>Note: Can be used with and without a switch.</i></p>
UCP 01511	<b>Waterfall Water Switch Toy</b> 	<p>Your own tropical paradise! User hit a capability switch and this unique water toy squirts water from flowers while a stream rambles down a volcano with multi-colored lights.</p>
UCP 00341	<b>Textured Roller Switch</b> 	<p>This special roller switch provides pleasing tactile stimulation that will make users want to roll it again and again. Spin the roller's drum to activate lights, music and vibration and enjoy a full somatosensory experience.</p>
UCP 00521	<b>Switch Adapted Scissors</b> 	<p>These switch-adapted scissors allow the user to participate in art and other classroom or home activities. Just activate a capability switch and the scissors will easily cut through paper. Easy to remove from special mounting.</p>
UCP 00324	<b>Starlight with Stand</b> 	<p>Once a connected capability switch is activated this fiber optic light provides 29 different light effects and six nature and new age sounds. This device has a volume control. The unit stands 4 feet tall on its leg (stands included) or 16-inches high when placed on a tabletop.</p>
UCP 01533	<b>Starry Night</b> 	<p>Activate a capability switch and relax to your favorite calming sound while watching the stars project on the ceiling. Sounds include birds, brooks, rainforest, ocean waves, and rain which help to develop listening skills. Light and sound can be used separately or together.</p>

UCP 02718	<b>Melody Bells</b> 	It's a carnival of light and sound! Spins a wonderful cascade of music when the user activates a capability switch. Eight colorful metal bells produce a clear tone when the striker ball hits them while LED lights flash.
UCP 00611	<b>Digital Camera with Switch</b> 	Real 1.3 megapixel camera with 4x digital zoom. 128 MB internal memory stores up to 1000 photos. This camera takes photos with funny stamps, borders, or silly photo effects and has video recording with sound.
UCP 01232	<b>Coby Adapted CD Player with Switch</b> 	This portable am/fm and cassette player has great sound. Just attach a capability switch and enjoy the music of your choice.
UCP 01234	<b>Adapted CD Walkman</b> 	Starts and pauses with each switch activation
UCP 01514	<b>Adapted 6 Switch ihome</b> 	Adapted iHome for an iPod! It's been adapted with six 2½" switches for easy access to the docked iPod controls. The user can control tracks forward and backward, volume up and down, pause, and off/on.



UCP 00596	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Adapted Mirror</b></p> 	When you pick up the mirror the lights turn on while the unit vibrates. This encourages the user to visually attend to him/herself and increases bi-lateral hand usage. The level of vibration is adjustable. <i>Note: vibrates only, lights do not work</i>
UCP 00199	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>LED Clip Fan</b></p> 	This fan has soft foam fan blades making it user friendly. Built in LED lights allow the user to create 64 different exciting light show effects and patterns. Fan has a separate on/off switch for the lights.
UCP 00203	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Magical Light Show</b></p> 	Press the yellow button and the user will feel vibrations under their hand while the light show begins. Provides great tactile awareness.
UCP 01255 UCP 01550	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Kissing Critters</b></p> 	These loveable little critters need the user's help to find each other! When their noses are lightly touched together the user is rewarded with lights, music and vibration. A fun way to develop hand-eye coordination.

UCP 00609	<b>Bubble Busy Box with AM/FM Radio</b> 	This box offers three stations: a vibrating plate, a pull ball that activates a removable fan, and a plate that activates an AM/FM radio.
UCP 01240	<b>Sound Effects Carousel</b> 	Twelve different sound effects are pre-recorded and played when the user presses on one of the 12 sides of this spinning toy.



UCP 00574	<b>Compact 3 Message Communicator</b> 	Small enough to fit on a lap or wheelchair table and plays four 5-second messages when the user presses one of three light-up switch plates. Above each plate is a compartment where users can place objects or insert pictures that correspond to pre-recorded messages.
UCP 00584	<b>Visual Speech Trainer</b> 	Practice forming words while looking in this communicator's attached mirror. Simply touch the device's plate switch to activate messages and begin visual speech training. The communicator accommodates four 5-second messages and can also be externally activated by plugging a switch into its jack.
UCP 00529	<b>My First Leap Pad</b> 	The My First LeapPAD pack engages user with fun, interactive stories and activities that teach reading and math skills! Letters, words and numbers come to life with the touch of the Magic Pen.




